




A Note from RA

Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday and then is a six-week period preparing for Holy Week. This year we will focus on Discipleship. But, thanks to the Lent Worship Design Team, we will weave in Lament AND Song, Mission serving out AND Mission reflecting in.

I have always enjoyed Lent for the chance to really practice spiritual disciplines for those 6 weeks. Who hasn't given up chocolate at least once in their lives? You are likely familiar with the idea of trying something for this time period. It is long but not too long. Check out the worship scriptures and themes (page 4) for more of what spiritual disciplines we will spend time with this season.

Holy week is always a highlight with the pageantry of waving palm, to Holy Thursday and then Easter Sunday and the Resurrection! This year, Holy Week and Passover have overlapping dates so for Holy Thursday we will have a Sedar, to experience that same celebration Jesus and the disciples gathered around for that Last Supper.



Other Lent Happenings

Each week during Lent we will substitute our communion bread for matzah, which is a flat, unleavened bread. This year Passover and Holy Week overlap, which is a reminder that the Last Supper as described in the gospels was a Passover Meal. The unleavened matzah bread was used by Jesus when he held it up and said, "this is my body". Specifically we will all use gluten free matzah to celebrate as one community.



Last year during Lent, we enjoyed having our Sunday School kids lead us in prayer so again we have invited them to participate this way!

Worship Visuals will help guide our worship. And I am still working on coordinating with the band as they lead us in praise and singing.

- Reflectors or solar lighting for parking lot entrances
- New water fountain with a bottle-filling station
- Directional and elevator signage
- Emergency lighting in stairwells
- Closet lighting


